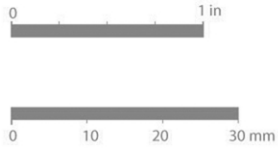


HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

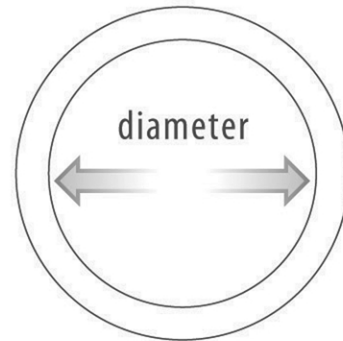


1. **Ring measurements are very precise.** Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.
2. **Prior to printing,** ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box. (To open the print dialog box, press CTRL+P.)
3. **Measure the bar on the left.** It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. Alternately, place a quarter where indicated. The quarter should fit completely over the image so that all lines are covered, without the quarter hanging over any edges.

MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.

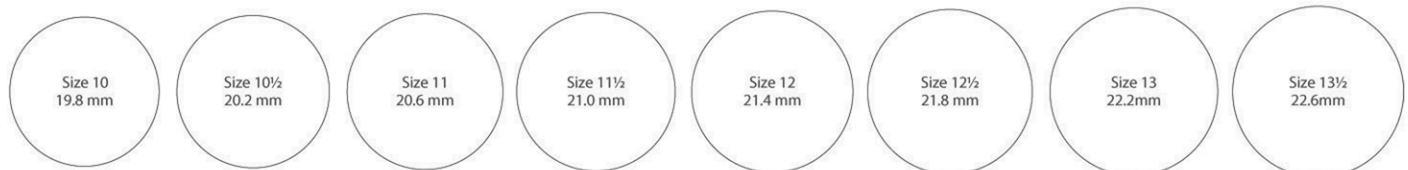
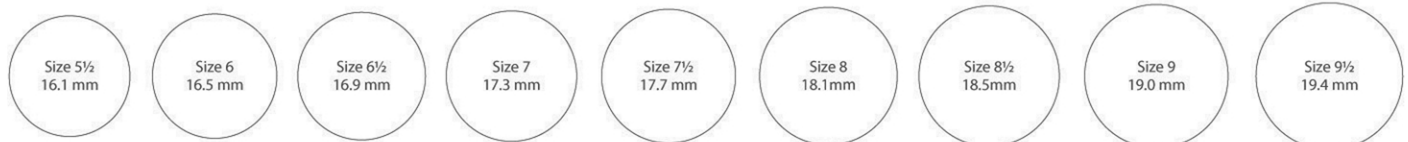
Engagement and wedding bands are traditionally worn on the ring finger on the left hand in the United States.



2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. The measurement refers to the *diameter* of the ring.

INSIDE EDGE OF THE RING

3. If the ring falls between two sizes we offer 1/4 sizes.
